

# Environmental Technician

## Lea County Government

Duties include patrolling rural areas to locate solid waste, weed control and animal control violations; issuing warnings or citations; investigating complaints; dealing with dead, injured or vicious animals; report-writing and recordkeeping. Must have high school diploma or GED and valid driver's license. Training in related fields preferred; some experience in animal restraint and care techniques preferred; ability to interact with the public calmly under stressful conditions a must. Must be able to lift up to an estimated 60 pounds. Variable work schedule possible; some overtime likely, including evenings, early mornings and weekends. Alcohol/drug screen and physical exam required if job offer is made. \$11.26/hour to start; county pays 95% of insurance premium and 75% of retirement contribution. Apply at Courthouse, Lovington, or Department of Labor, Hobbs.
