Subject: Cutting Lea County Road

Please follow these rules for cutting a Lea County Road;

- 1) All chip sealed roads must be cut with some sort of cutting equipment to keep a clean and straight line.
- 2) All cuts will be filled with flow-able back fill. (a combination of sand and two bags of cement per yard mixed with water)
- 3) All chip sealed cuts will be filled with flow-able back fill 2" from the top, then top off with 2" of Superpave bituminous pavement material.
- 4) All caliche cut roads will be filled with flow-able back fill 6" from the top, then filled with 6" of 3/4" base type caliche and compacted to a 96% compaction rate.
- 5) All other existing regulations for road crossing permits will still apply.
- 6) The company requesting the permit is responsible for any failures due to the cut in the future on this road.
- 7) The company requesting the permit is responsible for all traffic control.

If for any reason what so ever that the regulations for cutting a Lea County Road are not followed, your company will be requested to bore all roads from then on. It is the responsibility of the company requesting the road crossing permit to see that all regulations are followed.

This form must be signed by the party requesting the permit.
